Club Regulations 2010-2011

- *Club President Meetings (CP Meetings)*

CP Meetings are on the first Monday of every month and are mandatory; these meetings will be held once during lunch and once after school. These meetings show what will be coming up in the future, different ideas that can be shared within clubs, and the place to turn in club minutes.

- *Community Service*

Each club must do one community service project during each semester.

- *Club Minutes*

Each club must turn in minutes about what days and how long they had meetings. This ensures club commissioners that each club is doing what they said they would be doing. It can simply be written on a piece of paper signed by their advisor.

- *3 Strike Rule*

If a club does not follow one of the rules listed above (for example, not attending a CP Meeting) this can result in a strike. After two strikes the club will go on probation where club commissioners get the ability to let your club exist after doing another community service project or where the club can get dropped.
