- 4) What was/is an *alliance*, and who was Otto von Bismarck, and what did he have to do with *alliances*?
- 5) What countries were involved up the Triple Alliance & how did it create a new balance of power in Europe?
- 6) How did Kaiser Wilhelm II's quest for an overseas empire increase military rivalries and tensions in Europe?
- 7) *Who* made up the Triple Entente & *what* countries were involved?
- 8) Why were the Balkans called a "powder keg"? (Think about what a "powder keg" is / might be as you formulate your response.)
- 9) *Who* was Archduke Franz Ferdinand, *what* happened to him, & *why* was it significant?
