BACCALAUREATE

DATE: June 6, 2011
TIME: 7:00pm-8:00pm.
LOCATION: Seacoast Grace Church

DRESS: Wear your cap and gown and appropriate attire underneath. **Boys must wear pants and dress shoes. Girls must wear pants or skirts with nice shoes. NO flip-flops.** Baccalaureate is an inspirational (not religious) ceremony. It includes senior speeches, music and vocal presentations. This program is a warm, unifying event not just for the students but also for their families.

SENIOR LUNCHEON

GRADUATION

DATE: Tuesday, June 14, 2011
TIME: Report to the stadium at **4:00p.m.** The ceremony will begin **promptly at 5:00p.m.**
LOCATION: Cerritos College 11110 Alondra Boulevard, Norwalk
COST: Graduation – Free Parking - Free

You have worked too hard getting to this point to treat the ceremony in anything but a serious manner.

The stadium seats approximately 11,000 and we will have approximately 7,000 people in attendance. No tickets are needed for the graduation ceremony. Please drive carefully, as traffic will be heavy. **The ceremony will last approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes. No balloons, confetti or umbrellas are allowed in the stadium.** Graduates will have a close-up picture taken when receiving their diploma in the ceremony and a second photo where they pose with their diploma. South Coast Photographic will then mail each student a proof and an order form for any additional pictures. Parents will not be allowed on the field and are to greet graduates on the south side of the stadium and pick up the “real” diploma.
