Dr. Barke has been a Governing School Board Member of the Los Alamitos Unified School District (LAUSD) Board since 2006. He and his wife and two children have lived in Rossmoor since 1996. Both of his kids have attended LAUSD schools and most recently his son graduated from LAHS in 2016. His daughter attends DePaul University in Chicago and his son will be attending Hillsdale College in Michigan.
