Los Al Parents & Families:

With Common Core standards and teaching going into effect next Fall, Los Alamitos High School has begun an endeavor called Instructional Networking to help create avenues and pathways for teachers to have collegial conversations about the way instruction is delivered. It's a healthy way to learn from each other and develop our own practice among colleagues and friends!

And it absolutely works...

In fact, our effort to "network" has led to Los Al High participating in one of the first Instructional Rounds in all of Orange County. The idea of Rounds is rooted in the same professional growth model that medical doctors use when they observe each other practice and then modify what they do based on the best methodologies they observe. At Los Al, we're applying this concept to teaching. And the best part is, we're learning a lot!

When teachers are treated like the expert practitioners that they are, we are able to gain so much knowledge from each peer observation we make. And since Rounds is contextual and relies on the experiences and practices of similar teachers in similar settings, everyone who's participated has learned at least one new strategy that they can start implementing immediately in the classroom.

So, if your child comes home and says, "there were two teachers in my class today!" Or three, or even more. Just know that it's all part of how we're constantly working to improve our practice and get better at meeting the needs of our students in an ever-changing, always-demanding world.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Principal Arnold. Principal Arnold welcomed all in attendance and those present introduced themselves and stated their connection to Los Alamitos High School.

Principal Arnold reviewed the purpose of School Site Council which included the following:

1. Development of the School Plan
2. To review the implementation of the plan.
3. To assess the effectiveness of the school program.
4. To review and update the School Plan.
5. To approve appropriate budget items.
6. To advise the administration and the school staff regarding local school related and real and perceived needs, issues and problems.

Members present nominated and approved Daniel Patz to serve as Chairperson and David Eisenberg to serve as Vice-Chairperson.

Minutes of the April 2, 2012 meeting were approved as written.

Principal Arnold reported Homecoming Week is currently under way with designated Spirit Days and special activities scheduled. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony for the completion of the gym modernization

at the girls' volleyball game vs. Edison Oct. 2nd at 6:00 p.m. The game will be streamlined on the back of the gym wall live as an overflow crowd is expected. There will be a raffle after the game with prizes including an Amazon Kindle and gift cards. The Homecoming Assembly on Oct. 4th will showcase fall sports and introduce the Homecoming Court. The Homecoming football game vs. Marina is scheduled for Oct. 4th at Veterans Stadium where half time activities include crowning the King and Queen. It is also anticipated to be the 300th win for Coach John Barnes and all were encouraged to attend this momentous occasion.

Principal Arnold also reported many exciting practices and programs are occurring on campus.
