**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT REGISTRATION**

We welcome your student to the Los Alamitos Unified School District and hope he/she will have a very healthy and happy year! To ensure the optimum health of students and to comply with district, county, and state requirements, please note the following health requirements that must be met for enrollment:

**1. IMMUNIZATIONS FOR SCHOOL**

- Bring all shot records to register your child for school
- If your child’s immunization record is not complete: Call your medical provider now and make an appointment to receive missing required vaccines prior to registration.
- All required vaccinations must be submitted to complete the registration process.

<b>IPV / OPV</b> (Polio)	<b>4 Polio</b>	4 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement, as do: <b>3 doses, if <math>\geq 1</math> dose given at age <math>\geq 4</math> years.</b>	Must meet all K-12 grade requirements and will also need proof of Tdap given on or after 7 <sup>th</sup> birthday.
<b>DTaP / DTP –</b> Age 0-6 years <b>Tdap / Td –</b> Age 7+ years (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)	<b>5 DTaP</b>	5 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement, as do: <b>4 doses, if <math>\geq 1</math> dose given at age <math>\geq 4</math> years;</b> <b>3 doses, if <math>\geq 1</math> Tdap dose at age <math>\geq 7</math> years;</b> Tdap dose may meet 7 <sup>th</sup> Grade requirement.	
<b>MMR</b> (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	<b>2 MMR</b>	2 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement. <b>Doses must be given at age <math>\geq 1</math> year.</b>	
<b>Hep B</b> (Hepatitis B)	<b>3 Hep B</b>	3 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement	
<b>VAR / VZV</b> (Varicella or Chickenpox)	<b>2 Varicella</b>	2 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement.	
<b>1 Tdap –for 7-12 gr.</b> (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)	<b>1 Tdap</b> 7-12gr only	1 dose given at age $\geq 7$ years meets requirement for 7 <sup>th</sup> grade advancement and 7 <sup>th</sup> -12 <sup>th</sup> grade admission.	

**2. SCHOOL PHYSICAL EXAM FOR KINDERGARTEN AND FIRST GRADE**

All enrolling kindergarten students are required to present a certificate of a physician’s check-up (physical), performed within 6 months of entering kindergarten. First grade students new to the district must also present evidence of this physical exam performed within 18 months of entering first grade. This school physical exam may be free to those who qualify through the CHDP (Child Health and Disability Prevention) program. For information please call 1-800-564- 8448. Kindergarten or first grade transfer students who enroll after the beginning of the school year without the required physical assessment will be allowed 30 days to obtain and provide the school of attendance with the required physical examination or waiver.

**3. ORAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT FOR KINDERGARTEN**

*California law (Education Code Section 49452.8)* states your child must have a dental check-up in kindergarten or first grade, whichever is his/her first year of public school. A California licensed dental professional operating within his scope of practice must perform the check-up and complete Section 2 of the Oral Health Assessment Form. Dental check-ups performed within the 12 months before your child enters school also meet this requirement.

***Please note: Students will not be enrolled or admitted to class until the required immunization, physical exam, and dental check-up requirements have been met.***
