

Green Map Summary

This map divides Leisure World into four areas, creating an option where most trustee areas cross different parts of the District. All areas, except Area 1, include equal parts of Leisure World. Areas 1, 2, and 3 each have a portion of Los Alamitos. Areas 2 and 3 each have a portion of Rossmoor. Area 2 includes the northern and western parts of Los Alamitos and Rossmoor but does not include College Park West, which is linked to central Seal Beach in Area 5. Area 4 includes all of College Park East along with the eastern portion of central Seal Beach and Surfside. Four areas include portions of Seal Beach, with Areas 4 and 5 entirely in Seal Beach. Each trustee is in a separate area in this map. Trustee Davidson is in Area 1; Trustee Hill is in Area 2; Trustee Boyer is in Area 3; Trustee Russell is in Area 4; and Trustees Cutuli is in Area 5.
