The Los Alamitos Unified School District Child Development Center is currently accepting applications for the three hour State Program which operates five days per week. Enrollment is open to all interested families with children ages three to five. There is no charge for the State Preschool Program. Families who qualify by income may attend the program at the District Office Site at 10293 Bloomfield Ave., Los Alamitos.

The primary goal of the program is to provide a high quality educational opportunity in a trusting and positive environment. The center provides a setting in which positive adult-child interactions are modeled, and a special emphasis is placed on enhancing each child's self-confidence.

The staff includes experienced teachers with valid Child Development Permits, as well as assistant teachers who have received training in early childhood education. A part time speech pathologist is available to work with students who have language development needs and to guide parents in providing appropriate home experiences. The site has voluntarily undergone a comprehensive process of internal self-study to verify compliance with the Criteria for High-Quality Early Childhood Programs.
