#### **College Prep**

- Constructed around content standards, framework, and necessary subjectspecific skills.
- □ Provides students with high school graduation AND 4-year college admissions (UC/CSU a-g) requirements
- ☐ Diverse course offerings in all subject areas

#### **Honors**

- ☐ Expanded coverage of [some] content and subject-specific skills
- ☐ Increased depth of study
- □ Some, but not all, honors courses receive a weighted GPA point
- ☐ Offered in some, but not all, subject areas:
  - English
  - Mathematics
  - ☐ World Languages

#### Advanced Placement (A.P.)



- □ Designed to mirror the content, skills, and habits of mind of firstand second-year college courses
- ☐ Students can receive college credit(s) if they pass the A.P. exam
- ☐ Receive weighted GPA
- □ Suited for students who are: independent; motivated; have personal balance
